(HINT: You can use the four operations – addition, subtraction, multiplication or division to make a puzzle)


2. The Pin Code represents a system which divides the country into different regions, so for better communication codes are given to different cities.

Choose any one state and make a mask, which people use for dance, theatre, ritual, etc.


Write the name of the state on the Mask.
